Outline tasks

Our intention by publishing these before the competition is to enable you all to become familiar with, and plan for the tasks and come prepared to the briefings with a good understanding of the task. **These don't replace the detailed Task Descriptions given to Pilots in Quarantine.**

We have 'un-picked' the local regs and expanded the details. Our intention is that by releasing this information now pilots and team leaders can become familiar with the local procedures and the first briefings will be efficient and can focus upon tasks.

We have made some small improvements to these documents and added a few slides since the April bulletin, Start Points have been improved and the circuit procedures.

These have been updated to reflect the scoring and penalties that will be in place.

Electronic Devices and Self Declaration

In our local regulations please see **section 1.11.11 page 6** and the regulations concerning Electronic Devices. Please also see slide 15 of our Procedures document also. The Electronic Devices Declaration form can be found [HERE](#) If you are in any doubt about equipment in your aircraft please contact us before you travel and we can help you find a solution. To date we've received only one enquiry on Electronic Devices, if in doubt please contact us now.

FAI approved Flight recorders – 'FR'

In our local regulations please see **section 1.14** and 1.14.2 page 9.

We will only allow CIMA approved Type 1 FR, we've noticed a small number of pilots who have registered with non-approved FR's. These will not be suitable and we ask that you contact other team leaders who may have spare Type approved FR in their team and can loan you these for the duration of the championship.

Looking forward to the Practice Week

Please see the table on the next page which outlines the practice week. Two key events for you are:

Nav School – this builds upon a successful format at Hosin in 2022. Our team will guide you through a simple navigation task and give you opportunity to fly it and learn from this experience.

Official Practice Task 'O' this will be a dry run through a typical competition day. We plan to brief the task and run it as we intend to in the official competition week. This is a good opportunity to experience the quarantine conditions and planning times that will be in place for this dry run.

Competition Numbers

Vinyl numbers will be available for your aircraft upon arrival. We've allocated existing numbers if already in place and registered on the pre-registration form.

Economy Tasks

As you can see from the Task Outline documents there are two Economy tasks planned. We plan to pre-weigh specified amounts of fuel with which a reserve added will fit into a 20L container. Please ensure that your team members have sufficient containers to enable fuel to be pre-weighed in advance of the first task. Please also check the still air range of your team's aircraft noting the approx. distances in the outline task description.

Catering

There will be Full Catering on site with pre-published menus and the chance to pre-book and order. This will be provided by a local company who are using locally sourced ingredients. They are aiming to have a fixed menu and a range of themed nights and specials. Competitors will be provided with complimentary food at the Opening Ceremony and Closing Ceremony and a Lunch on one of the days. Pricing is as follows
